Rooted



Rooted means allowing Christ to infiltrate everything that you do, building a faith that runs deep.

Rooted means nourishing your faith so that you can stand when tough winds begin to blow.

Rooted means growing strong in your faith so that the influences around you don't choke out your passion for God.

As he scattered it across his field, some seeds fell on a footpath, and the birds came and ate them. Other seeds fell on shallow soil with underlying rock.
